#### **Job Objective**

Responsible for the day-to-day operations and events for the food truck. Role requires strong time management skills, food prepping skills, cleanliness, and excellent teamwork abilities.

In the performance of their respective tasks and duties all employees are expected to demonstrate to the following:

- Perform quality work within deadlines with or without direct supervision.
- Interact professionally with other employees, customers and vendors.
- Work effectively as a team contributor on all assignments.
- Work independently while understanding the necessity for communicating and coordinating work efforts with other employees.

#### **Essential Functions**

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Prepping items for events
- Handle day-to-day operations of food truck
- Drive the food truck to off-site events following all safety guidelines and laws
- Post shift organizing, cleaning inside and out, counting inventory, cleaning dishes
- Run the line
- Fulfill customer orders
- Ability to work under pressure during fast-paced events while maintaining the highest food/product quality
- Attend all scheduled employee meetings and brings suggestions for improvements as needed
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Head Chef or manager-on-duty
