Loveless Events is seeking a full-time Event Captain to oversee the day-to-day operations and execution of catered events across two on-site venues, off-site catering, and food truck events. The Event Captain acts as the venue representative, client liaison, and leader of the front-of-house team. This role requires excellent communication, proactive problem-solving, and the ability to ensure events run smoothly while upholding the high hospitality standards Loveless Events is known for.

## **Essential Functions**

### **Operations & Event Duties**

- Lead the execution of catered events in the Loveless Barn, Harpeth Room, off-site locations, or Food Truck.
- Oversee the food service timeline and maintain direct communication with kitchen to ensure all food is served accurately, replenished as needed, and consistently meets Loveless Events' quality standards.
- Attend weekly Banquet Event Order (BEO) meetings and carry out all event details.
- Be knowledgeable about the menu for each event to answer guest questions and accommodate dietary restrictions or allergies.
- Create and assign server duties to ensure smooth event execution.
- Assist in maintaining and reporting inventory levels of disposable items and equipment.
- Identify and resolve issues proactively in a calm, solution-oriented manner.
- Maintain cleanliness, sanitation, and organization of event spaces and storage areas.
- Pack, load, and unload vans for off-site events.
- Oversee Event teardown and cleaning; assign duties and assist as needed
- Complete post-event recaps and submit to the Event Team.

- Provide on the spot coaching, training, and feedback to ensure consistency and service excellence.
